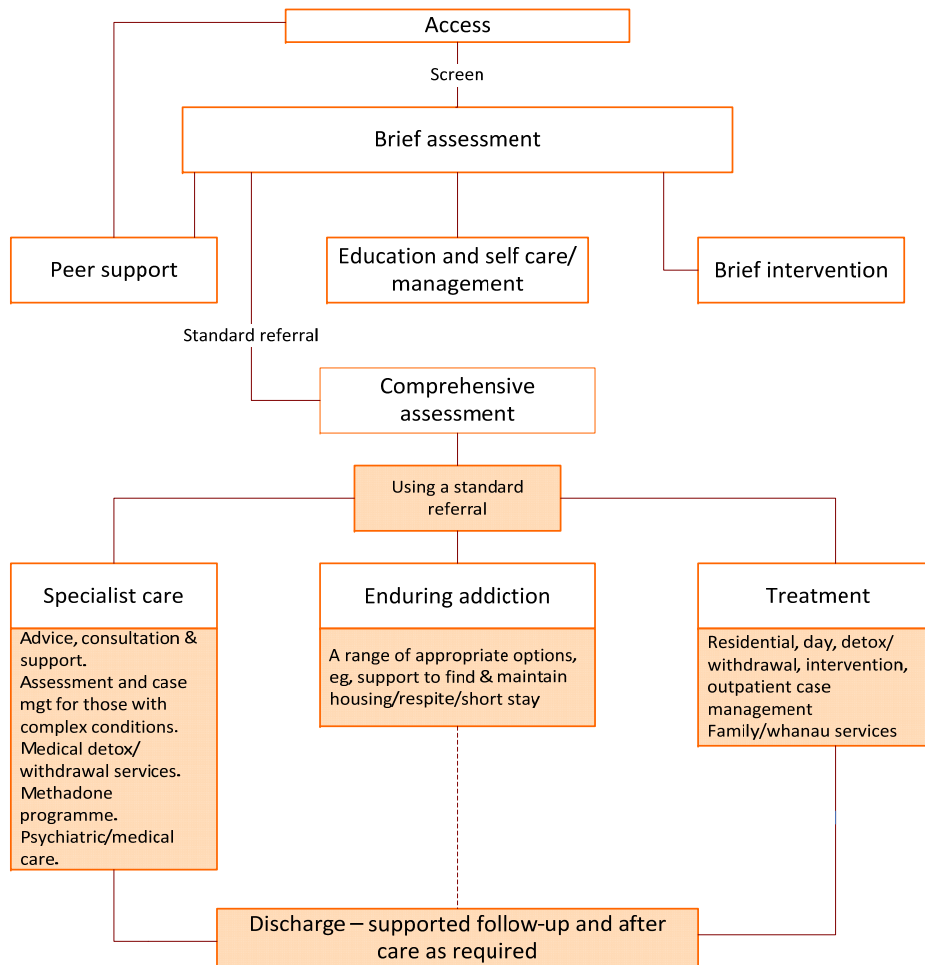


Tailored individual approach to care
Peer supported care and follow-up
Family/whanau inclusive
72 hour crisis care available
Specialist support and advice



An individual/family/whanau can access the pathway through primary care (GP Team, BIC), other mental health services, Justice system (Watch House, Probation Officer, Prison Nurse), (proposed) resource centre, peer support workers

A brief assessment undertaken by trained person at first point of contact, widely available in the community

The proposed resource centre to co-ordinate services for individuals. All services available to those who require them, regardless of access point

At any time, opportunity for brief assessment available, & undertaken prior to comprehensive assessment

Need for comprehensive assessment identified during brief assessment
Comprehensive assessment undertaken by those trained in process (eg, specialist team, post graduates AOD training)
Health (physical & mental), social, and justice 'need' differentiated.

Establish a single referral form for treatment/interventions

Develop intervention logic for all treatment programmes. Identify core components, outcomes and measures

Consider residential options of up to 12 week blocks as part of longer term management

Minimise self harm through support and pre-motivational services

Provide support so that people do not need to be 'using' again to gain access to support and services they require
