New Service and Updates

Clive Adventure Development: Gore Xpo at Croyden Lodge held last night main focus of discussion was establishing a rehab unit (service) locally. LOAD forum a good place to get input. Gore area discuss form of rehab unit (service) locally. The thoughts around this were inconclusive. Reasons suggested difficulty of getting locals into services in other areas

- waiting lists or support while waiting.
- No one taking referrals until next year.
- Problem getting into detox then no where (residential).

Q: What happened to Blair House?

A: No funding from DHBs, MoH.

Not sure what will come of this discussion, will a group be formed?

Comment: Good for Southland; going to Christchurch problematic.

- Setting up a steering committee suggestions
- As a team need to continue discussion
- Gore counselling may call another meeting to discuss further.
- Need at least a day counselling centre.
 - Don't really know how many people need a service.
 - How to sell the service to those who will be signing off this and use this service.

Suggested Models

- non therapy wrap around services
- Don't need a facility but specialist trained staff.
- Sending between AOD and other services.
- Has the field advanced are there other options.
- A Day Care Service may be good.
- Wrap around service – support from several agencies.
- Our services ability.

Not many liquor stores sold to underage people, suggesting supply is from known adults and parents

Comment: Also have home brewers supplying alcohol to under age.

Drink Sane Workshops PLA and PH around the sale of Liquor Act. Refresher training on not selling to young people. "Get Into It Not Out Of It" to general public not allowed on licensed premises if intoxicated, continuation of the ALAC promo on changing culture.

Q: Ho do you measure the success?

A: Young people from SADD will be asking people in the street if they know the brand where did they see it? No funds to carry out research.

Q: Targetting people who get intoxicated. What about the bars who serve?

A: All the bar staff invited to be involved in workshops. Police see it as a high priority. Joint project good buy in 23% of drinking done outside of licensed premises
